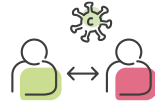




How to have a Clean Home & Help Stop the Spread of Coronavirus

On arrival:

- Resist any physical greeting
- Keep over 2 meters apart at all times
- Your cleaner should remove, replace or cover their outdoor shoes
- You should isolate in a separate room during cleaning (an empty property is best)



During:

- Your cleaner should wash their hands with soap and warm water for 30 seconds before and after the clean
- Ventilate your property by opening windows and turning on extractor fans



Personal Protective Equipment:

- * Your cleaner should wear a face mask/covering throughout the clean
- * Your cleaner should wear disposable gloves throughout the clean
- Wages to be paid via bank transfer if possible. Do not hand cash over directly



When leaving:

- Throw away disposable gloves, shoe coverings and consumable products
- Machine wash cloths and other cleaning items used
- Rinse any items that can't be machine washed e.g. mop heads



Disinfecting frequently touched surfaces should be prioritised:

- Worktops
- Cupboard handles
- Light Switches
- TV remotes
- Tables
- Stair rails
- Taps
- Door handles
- Appliance controls



Cleaning should be postponed if anyone in your or your cleaner's household show any Coronavirus symptoms:

- High temperature
- Dry cough
- Breathing difficulties
- Loss of taste and smell
